CASH/IPAD FOR GUNS

• Frequently Asked Questions:

- **Do I need identification to surrender a gun?**
 - No, absolutely no identification is required.
- **How do I bring a gun to the drop off site?**
 - Gun must be placed in a plastic or paper bag or box.
- **Can I transport the gun in a car?**
 - If transporting the gun by car, the gun must be transported in the trunk of the car.
- **When do I get the prepaid card?**
 - After the gun is inspected by a department specialist.
- **How many guns can I surrender?**
 - You may surrender as many guns as you wish, but you will only receive payment for up to three guns for a maximum payment of \$600.
- **Is there a phone number I can call for more information?**
 - Yes, you can call 646-610-5323 for more information on the NYC Gun Buy Back Program to reduce violent crime.
- **Can any member of the public surrender a gun?**
 - Yes, (active or retired law enforcement officers and licensed gun dealers are not eligible to participate in the program).
- **Can I have someone surrender the gun on my behalf?**
 - Yes, someone else can surrender the gun on your behalf.
